COVID-19 GUIDELINES

LIMITING ENTRY NUMBERS AND FAMILY MEMBERS

There will be an entry cap of 550. One adult per dancer is permitted upon entry. Please plan ahead in order to abide by this rule.

OUTDOOR VENUE

Please note that our venue is all outdoors. You must bring your own chair. If you wish to bring a tent for coverage, it should be no larger than 10 x 10 and must be secured to the ground with stakes.

LIMITING TIME AT THE VENUE

We ask that you do not enter our grounds before your designated start time. Once your competition has ended and your results have been posted, we ask that you please exit the venue promptly.

MASKS

Everyone will be required to bring and wear a proper mask correctly over their mouth and nose AT ALL TIMES. The only time a mask is optional is when the dancer is competing on stage. Anyone unwilling to comply with this requirement will be asked to leave the premises. Competitor masks worn on the day of competition may not have the dancer's school logo or name on it.

We suggest that dancers bring a small gift size bag with them side stage to place their mask in while performing.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Attendees must maintain social distancing at all times from others. To help ensure the safety and well-being of all feis attendees, Hurley Feis Volunteers will be monitoring all areas to ensure social distancing protocols are being followed throughout the event. We appreciate your cooperation in following all directions from our volunteer staff.

PAPERLESS REGISTRATION

Competitor numbers must be printed from www.feisweb.com in advance. Competitor numbers will not be available upon arrival to the fairgrounds.

COMPETITION STAGES AND DANCING ON STAGE

All dancers will dance two at a time. Dancers will have the option to remove their mask and hold it while dancing, or place it side stage in a bag.

RESTROOMS

Indoor restrooms will be available inside the front entrance of our volunteer & hospitality building. No changing or applying makeup in the bathroom, please be prepared to do hair and make-up ahead of time or outside.

AWARDS

Grade awards will be posted online and pickup will be available towards the exit of the fairgrounds. A decision will be made regarding the championship award process approximately two weeks in advance.

FOOD

Attendees will be allowed to bring coolers. Food trucks will also be on site. All social distancing rules must be followed when consuming food.
